

### Planned Parenthood: Setting the Record Straight

- 1. Planned Parenthood is the largest abortion provider in the U.S** In 2015-2016 (the latest year on record) Planned Parenthood affiliates performed 328,348 abortions, over 1/3 of all abortions in our country.
- 2. Planned Parenthood performs almost 26 times more abortions than it does birth-oriented services and counseling.** PP provided pre-natal services to 9,419 patients, and referrals to other agencies for adoption to 2,889 patients; compared to abortions to 328,348 abortions, i.e., 96% of services rendered were abortions.
- 3. Planned Parenthood offers fewer women's health services even as government funding has increased.** From 2004 to 2015, Planned Parenthood reported decreases in health services to women: Pap tests (down 75%); breast exams (down 65%), and total cancer screenings (down 69%). In comparison, abortions increased by 29%. Planned Parenthood's "screening" for breast cancer is a preliminary screen that a woman can do for herself – it offers no mammograms or biopsies. Women's comprehensive health needs are much better served by community health centers and other federally qualified health centers, which serve over 24 million patients and outnumber Planned Parenthood clinics 15 to 1.
- 4. Planned Parenthood does not believe in one's "right to choose" against abortion.** "Freedom of choice" does not apply to those who disagree with Planned Parenthood. PP opposes laws recognizing the rights for doctors, nurses and health facilities with moral or religious objections to abortion.
- 5. Planned Parenthood is not "pro-choice" for women.** In response to the failure of contraceptive programs to reduce unintended pregnancies, PP has increasingly promoted intrauterine devices, implantables and injectables – that can sterilize women for months or years. These techniques disregard a woman's own changing reproductive goals and cannot be discontinued without medical assistance.
- 6. Planned Parenthood promotes risky "emergency contraception" to minors.** PP promotes over-the-counter sales of high-dose "emergency contraceptive" (EC) pills, even to minors below the age of 15.
- 7. Planned Parenthood fights even modest laws to reduce or regulate abortions.** PP has opposed, and filed suit against, reasonable and widely supported measures on abortion, including those that protect a woman's health and informed decision-making, e.g., parental notification before a minor daughter's abortion; bans on the gruesome partial-birth abortion procedure; and laws ensuring a woman's informed consent, e.g., allowing her to view an ultrasound or providing her a 24-hour waiting period for her to consider her decision.
- 8. Planned Parenthood, a legal non-profit, reaps enormous profits, including revenues from taxpayers' dollars.** PP had revenues of \$1.35 billion in the year ending June 30, 2016, netting a profit of \$77.5 million. \$554.6 million, 41% of total revenue, is from taxpayers' dollars.

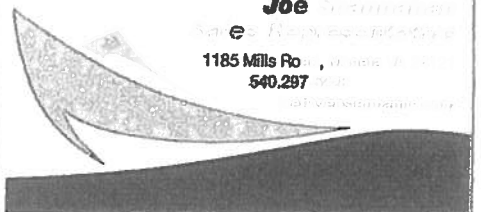
