**Note from Tami** Do you have supplies you could donate to the Medical First Aid Kit? If so, please place them in the cardboard box designated for them. Some of the supplies needed: unopened sterile bandages sizes 3x3, 4x4 + 5x9 (not outdated), rolled gauze in assorted sizes, eye shields, eye pads, larger triangular bandages (that can be used as slings), aluminum finger splints, instant cold packs, extra long sterile cotton-tipped swabs, duct tape, scissors, tweezers, antiseptic solutions, towelettes, thermometers and covers for them, turkey baster or other bulb suctioning devices, sterile saline, first-aid manuals, sterile gloves, flashlights, stethoscope, BP cuff, rolls of triage tape: red, yellow, green, or black. 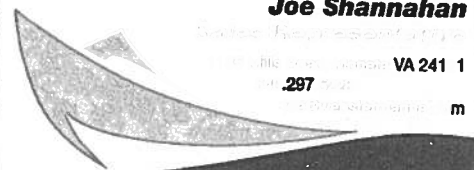
