Originally designed as a home for the Bishop in 1907, the building previously had been home to Cathedral Parish offices, which are now located next door at 823 Cathedral Place – the former home of Catholic Campus Ministry (CCM), which has moved to 20 N. Laurel across from the Cathedral. More details to follow once the extent of the repairs and the budget are finalized.

Note from Tami Do you have supplies you could donate to the Medical First Aid Kit? If so, please place them in the cardboard box designated for them. Some supplies needed are: unopened sterile bandages sizes 3x3, 4x4 + 5x9 (not outdated), rolled gauze in assorted sizes, eye shields, eye pads, larger triangular bandages (that can be used as slings), aluminum finger splints, instant cold packs, extra long sterile cotton-tipped swabs, duct tape, scissors, tweezers, antiseptic solutions, towelettes, thermometers and covers, turkey baster or other bulb suctioning devices, sterile saline, first-aid manuals, sterile gloves, flashlights, stethoscope, BP cuff, rolls of triage tape: red, yellow, green, or black.
