RESURRECTION CATHOLIC CHURCH – Safety Note 2

The Safety Implementation Team is pleased to advise that safety and security at RCC has improved. This note is a summary of those improvements. There is no catalyzing factor that triggered these improvements. It is simply a matter of prudence because we know that, should an event occur, advance preparation will result in a better response. This has been sufficiently demonstrated elsewhere.

Sheriff's office coverage. We now have in place an agreement with the Bedford County Sheriff's office (BCSO) to ensure coverage at our Masses. This includes traffic direction after all weekend and holy day/feast Masses. It also includes a deputy's presence on-site throughout the service so that, in case there is an emergency event, natural or man-made, appropriate direction and assistance will be available to the congregation and to responding emergency vehicles. The Safety Officers have established relationships with the deputies. Should you meet one of the deputies, please extend your thanks. Besides their presence, they have provided good suggestions to further improve safety at RCC.

Improved Security. We have arranged for the installation of new external surveillance cameras showing the access driveway and parking areas. These areas will be monitored 24/7/365 and viewable inside by designated staff and volunteers. The cameras are motion activated and recordings are retrievable for subsequent review. Inside surveillance is not planned. We have also arranged to bring our locks up to current electronic standards. This will allow much better management of building access. The cameras and locks are expected to be operational very soon. This is particularly important for the safety and security of staff and volunteers who currently operate in a mostly insecure and non-visible setting. The door at the front of the church to the left of the altar is locked at all times and it is available for egress only. You will not be able to use this door to enter the church.

Capital Improvements - Exits. In the event of an emergency, multiple exits are ideal for fast and safe evacuation. Presently the limited exits at RCC will probably make an evacuation here much less efficient, particularly for the mobility challenged, so being prepared is very important. The Capital Improvements Committee is evaluating this vulnerability and the actions recommended by the safety assessment team in 2018 which suggest the addition of new exits, with priority for the mobility challenged. As these are major projects, they will be considered in future church renovation.

Safety Officers. A new ministry of Safety Officer (SO) has been established. Each Mass has a SO who has oversight responsibilities of all aspects of church security especially during Mass. The SO will make sure that all doors are locked during Mass and will be in radio contact with the BCSO on duty. The SO will be able to remotely monitor doors and lock or unlock individual doors. In the event of an emergency, the SO can provide overall direction to the ushers and parishioners. We currently have several SO's and are in need of additional volunteers including an individual to lead this ministry. Contact Dave Wilmesher for more information.

Protocols. Protocols have been prepared for how to respond to various emergency situations. These are now being reviewed and when finalized they will be shared with you in future Safety Notes.

Medical Supplies. Several bags containing medical supplies have been assembled. These have been placed at several locations and the SO or Parish Nurse should be able to retrieve them quickly if needed.

Utility Shut-offs. All utility shut-offs have been mapped with labeled illustrations so that anyone will know where to look and how to turn them off and on. These instructions will be posted in strategic places of the building for general use. Contact Brad Rings for more information.

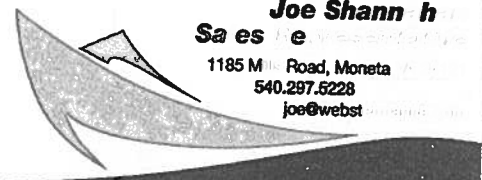
