The QCD fully counts towards your RMD, but does not have to be declared as income on your IRS Form 1040, so you effectively avoid paying tax on the distribution. Ask your financial institution about doing a Qualified Charitable Distribution to RCC.

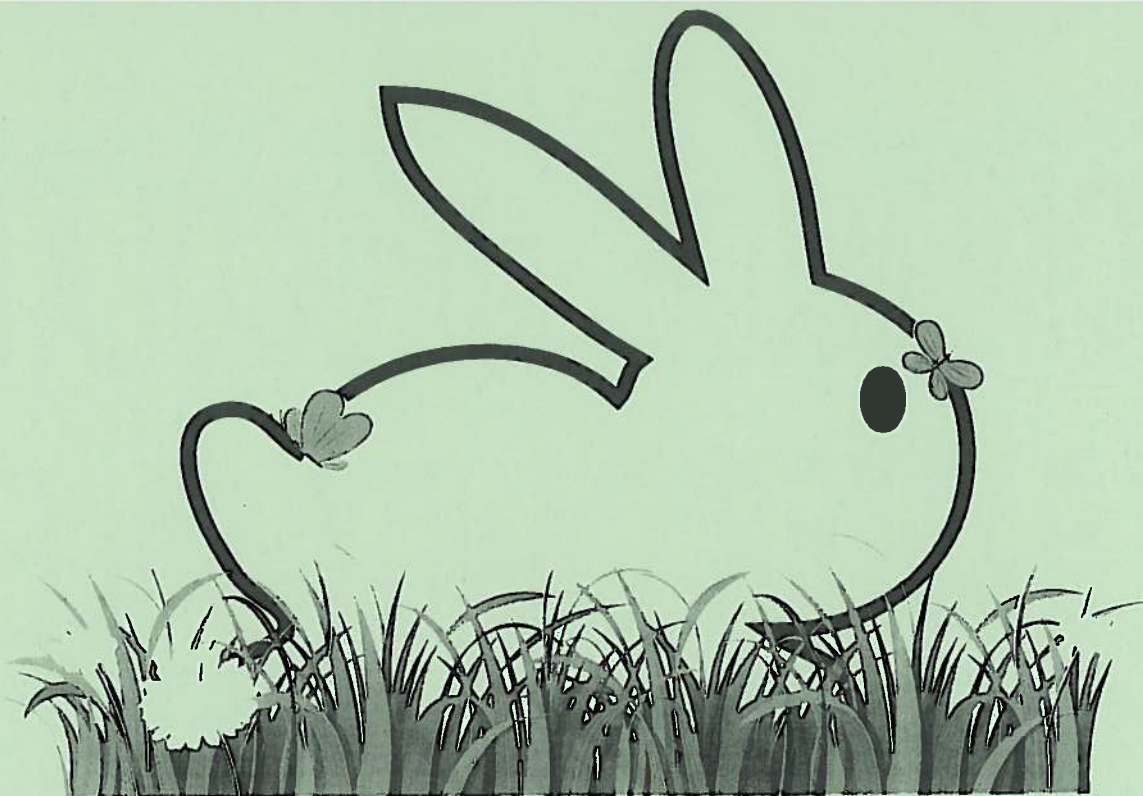
