SAFETY & SECURITY CORNER

Recently during a funeral service at Trinity Ecumenical Parish, a locked car was entered and the contents removed. Access was gained through a window left open slightly to dissipate the heat.

Also, a woman's purse was taken from inside the church, and her car was stolen. The thieves were captured in Maryland with help from surveillance camera footage.

We encourage everyone to roll up your windows, lock your vehicles, and secure items to keep them out of sight. Do not leave valuables unattended.

Awareness is often the key to prevention, so if you notice anything unusual, notify the Safety Officer or an Usher. We think the presence of a Bedford County Sheriff's officer during Mass presents a great deterrent, and our surveillance cameras are positioned to cover entrances and key church surroundings.
