PARISH FALL RETREAT! 10/3 & 10/4

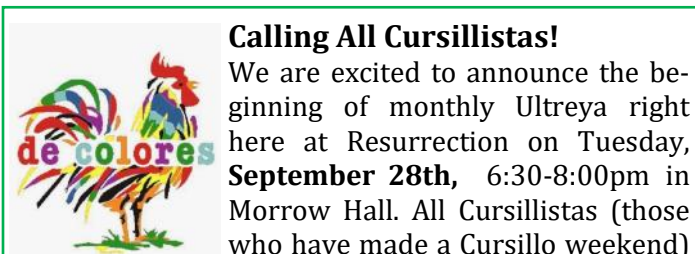
Whether you are feeling alone, weary, worried, or overwhelmed by life right now, this retreat will help us all focus on the TRUTHS of Jesus Christ!
