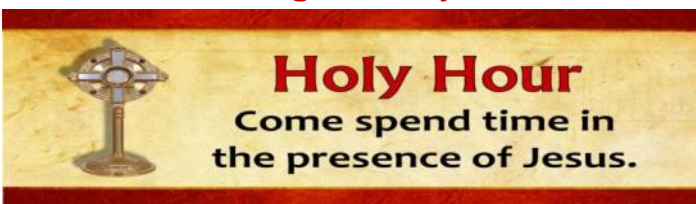

More from our Respect Life Ministry: On the back inner cover of our blue hymn book, located throughout RCC, are two prayers: The **Prayer to Saint Michael the Archangel** and the **Memorare**. We pray to Saint Michael because he held an important heavenly role in doing battle against evil, protecting Christians against assault from the devil. The Memorare prayer is a "powerful" prayer and has been proven to work miracles over the last 500 years. We asked our Mother, the Blessed Virgin Mary, for her intercession to stop evil. We will be reciting these two prayers after each mass during the 40 Days for Life to obtain help in the battle against the forces of darkness and against the evil spirits that live in abortion facilities in this world.

... And now you know!

Ever wonder why we have two columns of numbers on the **song board**? The numbers on the left are the hymns that are specific to this Mass, including the responsorial song. The numbers on the right are the "service music". These are sung prayers that we use every week, like the Gloria.

Generally, all the service music is in the same musical setting. In a musical Mass setting, all the different service music has the same musical theme, that is, the music itself is similar throughout all the pieces. And for each setting the composer has tried to create music matches that setting.

For example, we are currently using a "Mass of Creation" Mass setting. You may notice that all the pieces of music for that Mass setting sound somewhat similar. And, to the composer (and hopefully the person in the pew singing or listening) that music evokes the glory of God's creation.
