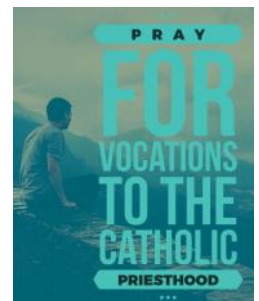

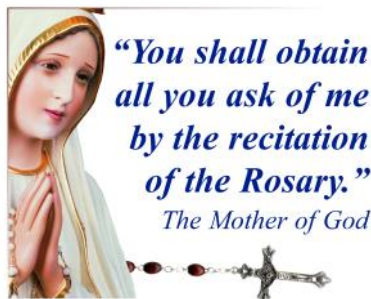

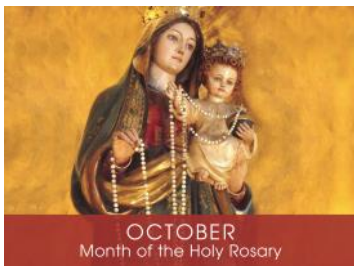
Nationwide Rosary Rally

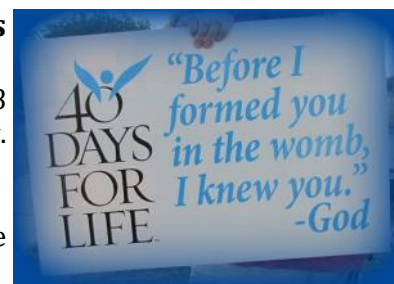
