“Night of Light” is a Fall celebration that celebrates all things LIGHT!

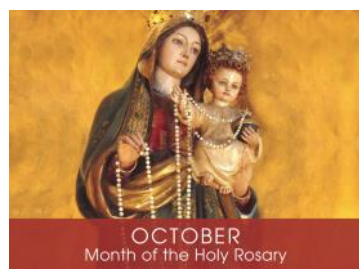
