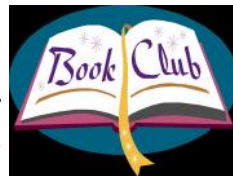


Potluck Dinner and Movie Night

This 3rd Sunday of Ordinary Time was set aside as **Sunday of The Word of God** by Pope Francis in 2020 to set aside "a Sunday given over entirely to the word of God, so as to appreciate the inexhaustible riches contained in that constant dialogue between the Lord and his people". It is not considered a separate feast day, but rather provides a spotlight on the Word of God as Jesus present in the Holy Scriptures that are read every week.
