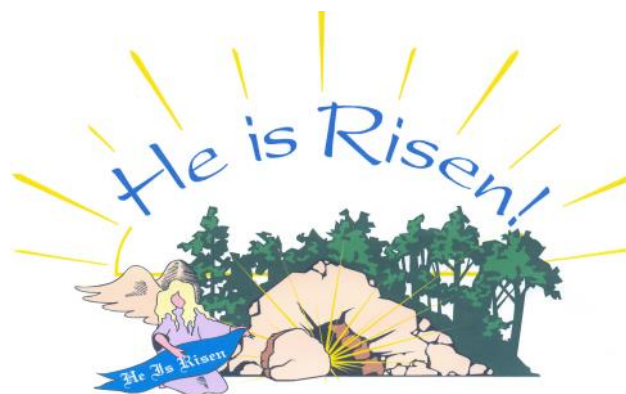

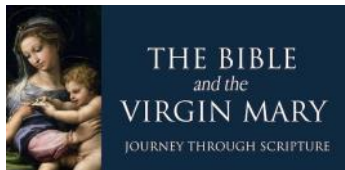

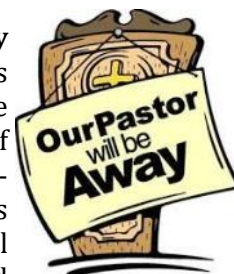
IMPORTANT UPDATES

Renovation Project Update

The Renovation Committee is currently reviewing the final schematic design drawings and cost estimates that were received on March 31st. Father Nixon and several members of the Renovation Committee are now tentatively scheduled to present these documents to the diocesan Building and Renovation Commission (BARC) on May 4th. Father Nixon will join via Zoom from the Philippines. Upon receipt of approval from Bishop Knestout to proceed, project implementation will commence. Once construction drawings are completed and requisite permitting is obtained, actual construction is expected to begin during the 3rd quarter of 2023.



Father Nixon will be away until **May 13th**. He had planned to visit his home in the Philippines during the month of May and return the first of June. The death of his sister has resulted in his leaving a couple weeks earlier than expected, and so he will return earlier. We wish him well and pray he has safe travels and is blessed by his visit with family during this difficult time.



Some have asked what we can do to support Father in his grief. If you want to send notes and cards, you may send them to the church and we will make certain Father gets them.

NOTE: We will not have Thursday Mass and Holy Hour until Father returns. Visiting priests will celebrate our weekend liturgies.
