November- The Month of Remembrance

In Catholic tradition, the month of November is a month of remembrance. It starts with All Saints Day, when we remember those faithful who have gone before us, followed by All Souls Day when we reflect on our own loved ones who have passed to eternal life, and it ends with the feast of Christ the King, where we reflect on the end of days and Christ coming in glory.

All Saints Day (Tuesday, November 1) Mass at 12:00. This is a **Holy Day of Obligation**.

On **All Souls Day** (Wednesday, November 2) at 2:00 there will be a short prayer service in the Prayer Garden and a blessing of the graves in the cemetery.

On the first weekend in November, we will remember those of our parish who have passed into eternal life in the last year. As we have done in the past, each name will be read, and a candle will be lit for **Remembrance of the Dead** at the start of Mass. We will display the Book of the Dead in the sanctuary during November up until the start of Advent. Please add names of loved ones who've passed away this past year.

We will have a Mass on **Thanksgiving Day at 9:30**. Parishioners are encouraged to bring the bread for their Thanksgiving meal to be blessed.

The next schedule will cover from the 1st Sunday of Advent up to Ash Wednesday (November 26 through February 19). PLEASE NOTE: The last day to submit changes is **NOVEMBER 4**. The date in the original "request for availability" was incorrect. This earlier date allows time for the schedule to be created and then posted two weeks ahead of the start date on that schedule.
