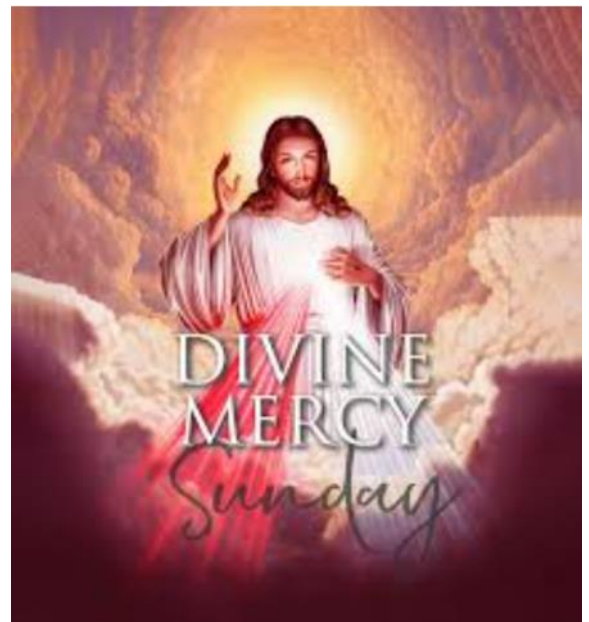

FAITH FORMATION & EVANGELIZATION

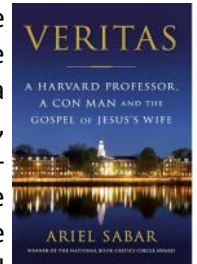
- ✚ Adult Faith Formation classes resumes Monday, April 8 at 10 am..
