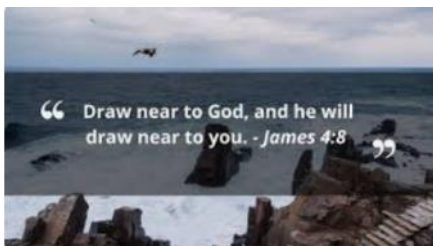

LITURGY & WORSHIP

CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION – June 2 following 4pm Mass.

“The Catholic Church professes that in the celebration of the Eucharist, bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit and the instrumentality of the priest. Jesus said: “I am the living bread that



came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world... For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink” (Jn 6:51-55). The whole Christ is truly present—body, blood, soul, and divinity, under the appearances of bread and wine—the glorified Christ who rose from the dead after dying for our sins. This is what the Church means when she speaks of the “Real Presence” of Christ in the Eucharist.

The Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, also known as the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, celebrates the institution of the Eucharist. The Corpus Christi procession is a centuries-old tradition of the Catholic faith to process the Real Presence of Jesus — the Eucharist.”*

This year Resurrection will have a procession on **SUNDAY, June 2**. The procession will take place immediately after the 4 pm Mass. We will process through the aisles of the Church. What a beautiful way to join ourselves to the National Eucharistic Revival!

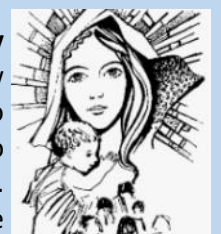
