IT'S TIME! MAINTENANCE REQUIRED!

Our wonderful church facility has been good to us since our last renovation more than 25 years ago. However, these past few years we have been fortunate, for the most part, to have been able to "limp long" to reach the point of renovation. Most recently, the elevator stopped working. We were told by the technician that the hydraulic system is the culprit and repair would be very costly. Whew! Since we do not need to rely on the elevator now, we were able to just put an "out of order" sign on the elevator. We have experienced similar issues with the roof, HVAC, lighting and sound systems. THE NATIVITY OF ST. JOHN THE BAPTIST-JUNE 24



The sole biblical account of the birth of John the Baptist comes from the Gospel of Luke. John's parents, Zechariah or *Zachary*—a Jewish priest—and Elizabeth, were without children and both were beyond the age of child-bearing. During Zechariah's rotation to serve in

the Temple in Jerusalem, he was chosen by lot to offer incense at the Golden Altar in the Holy Place. The Archangel Gabriel appeared to him and announced that he and his wife would give birth to a child, and that they should name him John, a name which was unfamiliar in Zechariah and Elizabeth's families. Acts 4:6 refers to a "John" (or "Jonathan", a name combining "John" with "Nathan") among the high priests who challenged the apostles' preaching after Pentecost, so the name was not unknown within the wider priestly family. However, because Zechariah did not believe the message of Gabriel, he was rendered speechless until the time of John's birth. At that time, his relatives wanted to name the child after his father, and Zechariah wrote, "His name is John", whereupon he recovered his ability to speak (Luke 1:5–25; 1:57–66). Following Zechariah's obedience to the command of God, he was given the gift of prophecy and foretold the future ministry of Jesus, this prophecy forming the text of the Benedictus canticle.



NOW THAT WE ARE AT TRINITY, YOU MAY BE WONDERING, WHERE IS THE BLESSED SACRAMENT KEPT?

During the week, the Blessed Sacrament will be stored in a small chapel downstairs in what was Classroom 8. This room was converted by the Tuesday Group into a very nice space that is appropriately reverent for the placement of the tabernacle. The tabernacle will be moved to the new chapel this Tuesday. (For now, access to the chapel is limited to the sacristans and the ministers to the homebound. This policy will be reviewed after we have the contractor on site.)

For each Mass, the sacristan will come to Resurrection and get the ciborium (which is the container with consecrated hosts) and bring it to Trinity. The ciborium will be placed on the altar and the altar candles will be lit before Mass. After Mass, the sacristan will return the ciborium with the Blessed Sacrament to the tabernacle at Resurrection.

Please recognize as you enter the sanctuary at Trinity that the Blessed Sacrament is on the altar, and this should be revered the same way you would reverence the tabernacle - by genuflecting or making a bow.
