EVERYONE is invited to attend the wine, cheese and cookie reception after both Masses **next weekend**. It will be the last weekend of Masses celebrated here at our location until after the renovation is completed. Come one and come all!

HOLY REMINDERS

The majestic image shows the world's tallest statue of Jesus. Known as the "Monument of Christ the King," it stands 33 meters (108 feet) high, in tribute to the age of Jesus when he was crucified. Completed in November 2010, the monument in Swiebodzin, Poland, serves as an inspirit reminder that Jesus is always with us.



Even if we don't see such a monumental reminder of Jesus local, nearly all of us can readily find other visible indications of God's love for us. The memorials on the side of the road (crosses, flowers, and candles) call to mind where someone died. And it's easy to see religious-themed bumper stickers, a church steeple, or Marian statues as we travel. Are we reminded of Jesus and the saints as we pass by a cemetery? Do we bless ourselves when we pass a church where the Blessed Sacrament is present? Do we consider how many names of places are reminders of the glory of God (San Francisco or St. Louis, for example)?

As people of faith, we know that God is always with us. Yet, we can still benefit greatly by having holy reminders ever before us. If you wish, sit quietly and reflect on the following question:

Where can I find reminders of God in my everyday life?
