CAN I LOWER MY TAXABLE INCOME WHEN TAKING MY REQUIRED MINIMUM DISTRIBUTION (RMD)?

While RMDs are taxed as ordinary income, you may lower your taxable income by donating to a charitable organization. A qualified charitable distribution (QCD) is a direct transfer of money from your IRA that's payable to an eligible 501(c)(3) charitable organization, which can also satisfy your RMD. 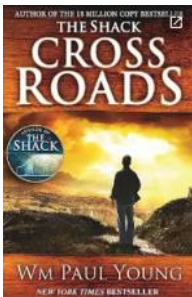
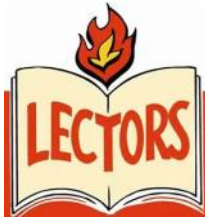
