NOVEMBER, THE MONTH OF REMEMBRANCE

In Catholic tradition, the month of November is a month of remembrance. It starts with All Saints Day, when we remember those faithful who have gone before us, followed by All Souls Day when we reflect on our own loved ones who have passed to eternal life, and it ends with the feast of *Christ the King*, the last Sunday of the liturgical year, when we reflect on the end of days and Christ coming in glory.

All Saints Day (Friday, November 1) Mass at NOON. This is a Holy Day of Obligation.

All Souls Day (Saturday, November 2) at 3:00 pm there will be a prayer service and blessing of the cemetery. Rain or shine, we will begin at the columbarium with prayer followed by a blessing of the graves in the cemetery.

On **November (2/3)** we will remember those of our parish who have passed into eternal life in the last year. As we have done in the past, each name will be read, but this year there will be a wooden cross placed in remembrance for each individual. We will display the Book of the Dead in the sanctuary during November up until the start of Advent.

We also celebrate Thanksgiving in November. This is a time to remember the early days of our country and be thankful for all that we have. We will have a Mass on *Thanksgiving Day* (**Thursday, November 28**) at 9:00 AM. Parishioners are encouraged to bring the bread and/or wine for their Thanksgiving meal to be blessed.


