VETERANS DAY MEMORIAL PRESENTATION

RENOVATION SCUTTLEBUTT

This week's project work is focusing on providing safe and protected entry-exit to our renovated church in case of severe weather events or emergency situations. The side door drive-through portico nearest to Route 122 will provide for drop-off and pick-up for those with physical disabilities and for all during inclement weather. The double door exit toward the back of the church, furthest away from Route 122, will offer rapid evacuation for those serving on the altar or seated in the front pews. This exit will include an ADA ramp component to accommodate those with disabilities.
