A reliquary shrine in Resurrection's chapel holds a first-class relic of St. Catherine Labouré, a gift to us at the founding of the parish by the sister of our first pastoral associate, Pat Marlar. Catherine Labouré, DC was a French member of the Daughters of Charity of Saint Vincent de Paul and a Marian visionary. She is celebrated for her visions of the Blessed Mother who re-



vealed the Miraculous Medal to Catherine in 1830. Labouré spent forty years caring for the aged and infirm. She is the patron saint of the elderly, infirmed people and the Miraculous Medal.


CHANGE...Take Note!
