

St. Catherine Labouré Feast Day – November 28

Our parish is blessed to have a first-class relic of St. Catherine Labouré, gifted to us at the founding of the parish by the sister of our first pastoral associate, Pat Marlar. St. Catherine Labouré is celebrated for her visions of the Blessed Mother who revealed the Miraculous Medal to St. Catherine and directed her to have them made with the promise that "All who wear it will receive great graces; they should wear it around the neck." St. Catherine was very humble about the role in the introduction of the Miraculous Medal. Only her confessor knew her identity until shortly before she died 45 years later. In that light, this year on her feast day, let us focus on the Miraculous Medal as it was revealed to her.
