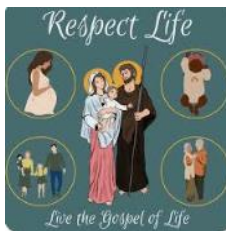

On the rare circumstance that a major weather event is predicted for weekend Masses, parishioners will be notified by Flocknote, website, and Facebook.

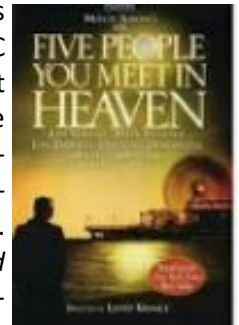

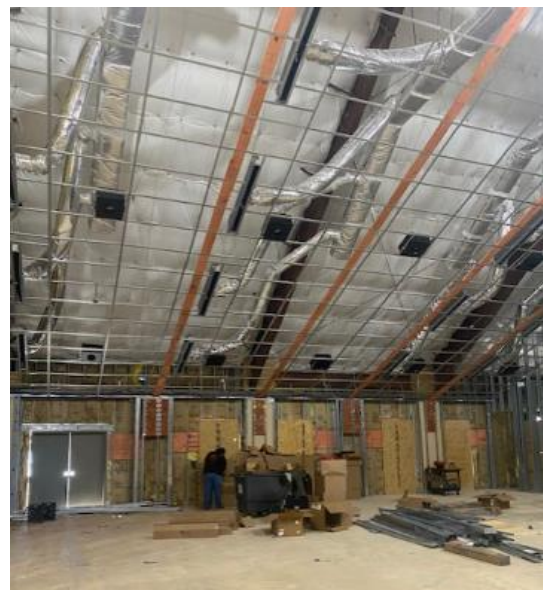
RCC BOOK CLUB
