- Listen to daily [Bible in a Year Podcast](#).

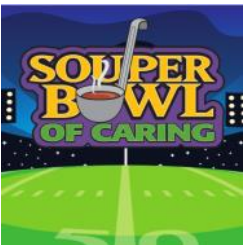
FAITH FORMATION & EVANGELIZATION
