RENOVATION SCUTTLEBUTT

Unfortunately, weather continues to be a work scheduling problem, but our contractor is nevertheless making progress. Drywalling in the sanctuary has been almost completed and prep work continues for installing specially-designed acoustical tiles in the worship area. This week Bob Flynn, Max Gaberdiel, and Joe Ferrara--with input from Tim Ernandes--reviewed and approved the renovation audio-visual system design recommended by our contractor's sound engineer. Outside, all required structural steel work for our main entry doors and bell tower has now been installed.
