***Approve February Minutes:** The minutes were unanimously approved.

NEW BUSINESS:

***Results of recent Fr. Pivonka Video offered to Parrish:** Most attended the first weekend. 75 people attended the 4 shows with positive feedback. Doug Skinner will send the next 25-minute video on Confession to Fr. Nixon to review. If approved, Doug will create the bulletin announcement and ministry minute to introduce and show the video on April 5 & 6th.

***Update/Discussion of Church Dedication:** At the 11am mass on June 29th, the Bishop Knestout will dedicate Resurrection's newly renovated church and bless the altar. A reception to follow in Morrow Hall.
