JUNE 29, SACRED HEART OF JESUS

KNEEL, SIT, OR STAND

When Resurrection was initially built, the bishop at that time permitted churches to be built without kneelers. The proper posture during the Liturgy of the Eucharist with no kneelers was to remain standing, if able, with a bowed head. However, bishops have changed, as well as the liturgical practices, since Resurrection was first built. New and renovated churches throughout the Diocese of Richmond are now required to install kneelers, so Resurrection's renovated church has kneelers. The expectation is for parishioners to use them after entering their pew to pray before Mass. The kneelers should also be used during the Liturgy of the Eucharist: after the Sanctus ("Holy, Holy, Holy") and after the Agnus Dei ("Lamb or God"). If you are not able to kneel, please sit. You may kneel or sit for prayerful reflection after receiving the Eucharist.



RENOVATION SCUTTLEBUTT

The final lap bell is ringing--literally! Our new bell was electronically activated this past week and you can now hear the hourly chime throughout the day. The Sanctuary is complete, and the wiring for our sound room and livestream system is connected. Landscaping around the church perimeter has also been finished. The final steps left to be done this upcoming week, prior to our June 29 Dedication Mass, are: (a) to install our signature draped cross stained glass window over the church main entry doors, (b) to complete the elevator installation and inspection, and (c) to obtain the requisite Bedford County final occupancy permit. The Renovation Committee sincerely thanks all parishioners for their support and patience in successfully implementing our renovation program!

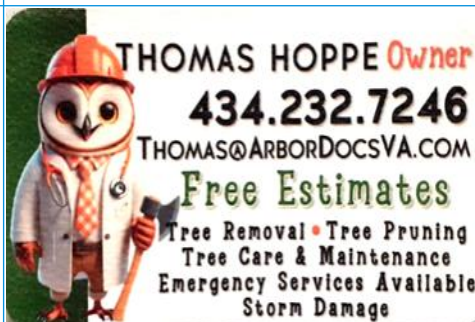
