

#### **ENTHRONEMENT OF THE BOOK OF GOSPELS**



At Resurrection the Book of the Gospels is enthroned after the Gospel is read. This is done when the deacon or priest places the Book of the Gospels on the front of the ambo after reading the Gospel. The enthronement of the Book of the Gospels signifies the presence of

Christ in the liturgy, as the Gospels recount the life, teachings, death, and resurrection of Jesus. As an Act of reverence to the presence of Christ, the Word of God, please remain standing until the Book of Gospels is enthroned after the Gospel is read.

#### PREFACE FOR THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER

Do you respond "Amen" when the Preface for the Eucharistic Prayer is said? The correct answer is that you do not. Many Catholic prayers end with the phrase "through Christ our Lord," which is then followed with "Amen." However, "through Christ our Lord" is not said as the end of the Preface. 
