Before Mass

- * Upon entering the church, make the sign of the Cross and bless yourself with Holy Water.
- * Genuflect (The bending of the right knee completely to the ground whenever possible, to convey adoration of the Altar and the Tabernacle) next to the pew before seating yourself.
- * **Respect the Eucharistic Presence and others' prayer time by maintaining silence.** Socializing should be reserved for outside the church. If you must speak, please do so quietly and briefly.
- * Turn off your cell phone.

LITURGY & WORSHIP

After the bread and wine are brought to the altar, the deacon or priest prepares the gifts. Prayers may be said aloud to which we respond: *Blessed be God forever*. The priest then invites all to pray: *Pray, brothers and sisters, that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God, the almighty Father*. After the priest concludes this invitation, parishioners should then rise and reply: *May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands for the praise and glory of this name, for our good and the good of all his holy Church*. Oftentimes, parishioners stand when the priest begins the invitation, but we should wait to stand until they respond.

PREFACE FOR THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER

Do you respond "Amen" when the Preface for the Eucharistic Prayer is said? The correct answer is that you do not. Many Catholic prayers end with the phrase "through Christ our Lord," which is then followed with "Amen." However, "through Christ our Lord" is not said as the end of the Preface. It is said in the middle. At the conclusion of the Preface we acclaim, "Holy, Holy, Holy."

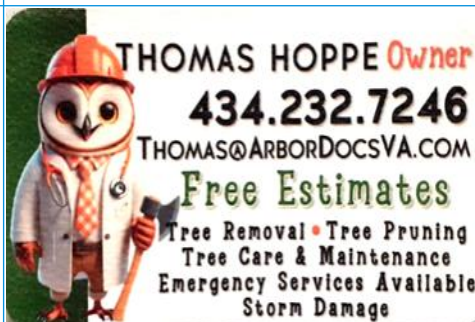
