LITURGY & WORSHIP

After the bread and wine are brought to the altar, the deacon or priest prepares the gifts. Prayers may be said aloud to which we respond: Blessed be God forever. The priest then invites all to pray: Pray, brothers and sisters, that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God, the almighty Father. After the priest concludes this invitation, parishioners should then rise and reply: May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands for the praise and glory of this name, for our good and the good of all his holy Church. Oftentimes, parishioners stand when the priest begins the invitation, but we should wait to stand until they respond.

PREFACE FOR THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER
