

ENTHRONEMENT OF THE BOOK OF GOSPELS



At Resurrection the Book of the Gospels is enthroned after the Gospel is read. This is done when the deacon or priest places the Book of the Gospels on the front of the ambo after reading the Gospel. The enthronement of the Book of the Gospels signifies the presence of Christ in the liturgy, as the Gospels recount the life, teachings, death,

and resurrection of Jesus. As an Act of reverence to the presence of Christ, the Word of God, please remain standing until the Book of Gospels is enthroned after the Gospel is read.

On July 1, 1983, the Catholic Community of Moneta was designated as an independent parish in the Catholic Diocese of Richmond. On Easter Sunday, April 21, 1984, Bishop Walter Sullivan approved the name Resurrection Catholic Church for the church to be built in Moneta
